

Image Expressions 2018 Guidelines - 1

Meeting Schedule:

- Second meeting of the month except where indicated
- Screening of submissions before coffee break
- Announcement of winners after coffee break

Competition Voting:

- Only Camera Club members present can vote
- Members will vote for one image only
- There will be 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th and 5th place winners

Competition Prize:

- There will be a draw from among the top five for a prize

Winners presentation:

- Each of the top five place winners will be given an opportunity to talk about their photo, should they choose to do so
- Winners will be acknowledged via e-mail message

Submissions:

- Email images to: cvpsimageexpressions@gmail.com
- The deadline for entries will be 5:00 pm the Sunday evening before the meeting
- Late entries cannot normally be accepted
- Each image received will have an email confirmation sent to the participant within 24 hours of its receipt

Image Expressions 2018 Guidelines - 2

Online display:

- An invitation to view the Competition entries in a Web Album will be sent to the membership the day following the entry deadline
- Challenge entries will be viewable the day following the meeting
- All entries will be permanently displayed on the Image Expressions Zenfolio website <http://comoxvalleycameraclub.zenfolio.com/>

Submission Criteria - Competition and Challenge:

- Each photo entry should be 1920 pixels on the long side (1920 x 1080 is ideal)
- Change the filename of the image to include your first name, last name, month of the event, the word "competition" or "challenge" and a title; e.g.: *Lauren Bacall Nov Competition—Mountain Meadows.jpg*
- If the image title is long, it can be sent in the accompanying message
- The submitting member must have taken the competition image within the past 12 months and the challenge image within the time frame specified (usually during the interval between successive meetings)
- Images must directly relate to the theme(s) of the month
- Members are allowed one entry for both the competition and challenge
- Each image must be in the correct orientation for viewing
- All entries must be in Jpeg format
- The Metadata must be intact so that eligibility for the competition and challenge can be determined
- Each individual photo can be submitted only once

Image Expressions 2018 Guidelines - 3

Evaluation Meeting Differences:

- Normally the entire meeting will be devoted to image evaluation
- There will be two themes—the competition theme for the month and Open
- The age restriction is waived for competition category images only
- Judge's scores replace the popular vote
- Members may submit one image in each category
- Submitters can request comments from the judge about one of their images
